Changes to timetable structure

for 2019—Following our review of the curriculum and timetable for 2018, we have made the following changes for the 2019 school year. The **Future-focus** programme will be offered weekly, occurring on **Wednesday afternoons** (along with the Senior Independent Learning times), beginning in Term Two. This will allow us slightly more teacher contact time during the busy Term One, yet still allows our senior students to develop their self and time-management skills. Students in Years 7-10 will again be offered a wide range of choices of academic, digital or health and wellbeing options. The other modification to the timetable is that Junior Chapels will occur on Wednesday and Friday mornings. **Thursday classes will start slightly later (9.15am)** as we have built in a weekly staff professional learning time and the sharing of best practice, between 8.30 and 9am on Thursday mornings. Whanau time will also be scheduled during the week as we move towards the implementation of Vertical Form classes. Our two-week timetable remains constant (10 days over 2 weeks) rather than having the flexible (moveable) Day 10, which did cause some confusion this year. Students will have ready access to their timetables on KAMAR, as per this year.
